Supplementary Regulations

1. AUTHORITY - CAMS Permit No. 318/1811/04

The event will be held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the [National Competition Rules \(NCR\)](#) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the current [National Motorkhana Code \(NMC\)](#), the current Victorian Motorkhana Championship (VMC) Standing Regulations, the CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity Policy, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations that may be issued.

The event will be held under and in accordance with the CAMS Safe Event Package for Motorkhana and Khanacross, and all Competitors are obliged to comply with all reasonable requests of the Organiser. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

The Organiser reserves the right to refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83 and to cancel the meeting if, in its opinion, insufficient entries are received. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel, postpone or abandon the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

2. EVENT DESCRIPTION

The event will be a multi-club individual and teams motorkhana conducted at the Pakenham Auto Club grounds, 405 McGregor Rd, Pakenham on **Sunday, November 18th, 2018**. The surface will be grass.

3. PROMOTER

The event will be promoted and organised by Huntingdale Auto Club Inc.

5. JUDGES OF FACT

Timekeepers and observers will be Judges of Fact as per Article 18.3 of the National Motorkhana Code.

6. ENTRIES

Entries open on publication, and close on **Friday, November 16th, 2018**. The entry fee is \$20.00 or \$10.00 for Junior Drivers. **For an entry to be valid it must be complete & received by Friday, November 16th, 2018.**

No entries will be taken on the day of the event. No phone entries.

Post completed Entry Form with payment to the **Event Secretary** at above address **OR** email scanned Entry Form to jennyros13@gmail.com with payment by EFT to HAC bank account: BSB 633-000 A/C No. 131786725, including **NAME** and the Reference - **HAC INTERCLUB 2018**. An entry without payment will not be accepted. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to Huntingdale Auto Club Inc.

Up to **FOUR** Drivers may compete in the same vehicle provided this is nominated on the Entry Form. The field will be limited to a maximum of 70 starters, and will be accepted in order of receipt.

Competitors will be required to produce proof of current membership of the club nominated on the entry form.

7. PERSONS ELIGIBLE

Competitors and Drivers must be holders of a current Level 2NS or superior licence issued by CAMS.

8. PARENTAL CONSENT

For any Competitor or Driver aged less than 18 years on the date of the event, the consent of his/her Parent or Guardian must appear on the Entry Form.

9. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will commence at 8.30 a.m. and conclude at 10.00 a.m. on the day of the event. All cars must be scrutineered and passed prior to participating in practice (if permitted) or competition. Valid CAMS Licences, Current Club Membership cards, CAMS Vehicle Log Book (if issued) and Competition Record (if issued) must be produced at scrutiny and/or **on request during the meeting**. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

10. VEHICLES

Vehicles must comply with Section 6, Schedule A of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and also the rules for Group 4H Motorkhana cars. All vehicles must be adequately muffled. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. **Wintertread, hand-cut or Rally-type tyres** will NOT be permitted.

11. PASSENGERS

This event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the [CAMS MSPRA Policy](#). During competition, not more than one passenger, aged at least 12 years may be carried per competing vehicle. Passengers must have completed a [Passenger Ride Entry Form and Disclaimer](#) and must attend the Drivers' briefing. They must be securely restrained by a seat belt and not permit any part of their body to protrude from the vehicle nor assist or hinder the Driver in any way. A passenger may be prohibited from taking any further part at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. The Passenger must wear the same protective gear as a Driver

12. SAFETY

(Schedule D – Apparel) Adequate footwear must be worn by all Drivers and passengers whilst competing - bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted. Where no windscreen is fitted to a vehicle, Drivers and passengers must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing. All Drivers and passengers must wear at least a lap type seat belt whilst competing.

13. DRIVERS BRIEFING

All Drivers and passengers (with Parent/Guardian if under 18) must attend the briefing to be held at the event at approx. 10.20 a.m. The running order will be notified at the conclusion of the Drivers' Briefing.

14. TESTS

A minimum of four and a maximum of twelve tests will be conducted.

15. START

The event is scheduled to start at 10.30 a.m.

16. TIMING

Timing will be by means of electronic &/or digital stopwatches, one nominated as official time, and the other as a backup.

17. PENALTIES

Penalties will be as per the 2018 Victorian Motorkhana Appendix except that reference to slowest time or fastest time will apply only to that class.

18. EXCLUSION

Failure to comply with an instruction given by an official of the meeting may result in that Competitor being excluded from the event by the Director. Leaving the marked competition area in a dangerous manner will result in exclusion from the event.

19. PROTESTS

Any protest/s must be lodged in accordance with the provisions of Part XII of the NCR.

20. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.

21. CLASSES

The competition will be divided into the following classes:

- A** Production cars (2WD, Engine over Drive Axle or Mid Engine), wheelbase up to 2450 mm
- B** Production cars (2WD, Engine not over Drive Axle), wheelbase up to 2450 mm
- C** Production cars (2WD, Engine over Drive Axle or Mid Engine), wheelbase 2451 - 2660 mm
- D** Production cars (2WD, Engine not over Drive Axle), wheelbase 2451 - 2660 mm
- D1** Production cars (2WD), wheelbase 2661 mm & over
- E** Production cars (4WD or AWD)
- F** Specials
- J*** Juniors (under 18 on the date of the event)
- L*** Lady Drivers
- N*** Novice Drivers (Drivers who have totaled less than 9 class, category or outright VMC points in any year prior to 2018 or at the discretion of the Clerk/s of the Course).

NOTE: * Competitors eligible for classes J, L or N may nominate to compete in **either** one of those classes **or** the appropriate vehicle class. Competitors in classes J, L and N will have their total time multiplied by a handicap factor based on the class of vehicle used as follows:- Class A: 0.92, B: 0.88, C: 0.88, D: 0.84, D1: 0.80, E: 0.92, F: 1.00.

Competitors must nominate their class and club BEFORE 10.00am (scheduled close of scrutiny).

22. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded to 1st Outright and 1st in each class.

23. HAC INTERCLUB TROPHY

In each class, Competitors will be awarded points, ranging from 6 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 6th place. The class points for the six highest point scorers from each club (who become the Team Members) will be totaled.

The **HAC INTERCLUB TROPHY** will be awarded to the Club with the highest total of points, and Medallions to each of the winning Team Members.

24. FACILITIES

Food and drinks (breakfast, lunch & snacks) will be available at the venue, as are toilets. Please **DRIVE SLOWLY** near and within the venue.

25. CANCELLATION

If there is extreme rain in the area, the event may be cancelled. If in doubt phone 0425 722 706, 8am to 9pm pre-event.
